APPEARANCE AGREEMENT FOR BRYAN SAINT TECHNICAL RIDER & REQUIREMENTS (250+ People)

We are excited to work with you! Please contact us with any questions regarding this rider.

THE SHOW

1. SOUND: Lavaliere mic and capable operator. In case there should be a technical issue Bryan also likes a wireless handheld mic on a basic mic stand(not a podium) as a backup.

2. LIGHTING: It is important that the entire performance area be well lit. Also, because the show is very interactive, Bryan prefers that the house lights be up for the performance.

3. STAGE AND PLATFORM: A raised platform **at least 16ft wide by 8ft deep** is required. Please contact us if this can't be obtained. Also, the platform should be raised a minimum of 3 feet with steps leading down to the audience.

4. SEATING: The first row of chairs or tables should be at a distance of <u>5 feet or less</u> from the performance area(*Please see "STAGE LAYOUT" on the second page*). Bryan hands items to people in the front row during the performance. We know that this may seem close, however, with hundreds of audiences of all sizes tested, without question, the closer the audience, the better the show. ***There is to be <u>NO dance floor between the stage and the audience</u> during the show. Tables and/or chairs can easily be placed on the dance floor and then removed when the dancing begins. If a dance floor is between the stage and audience on the date of the event and cannot be rearranged prior to showtime, it may the result the performance's immediate cancellation. In case of such an event, payment in full will be required!***

5. BANQUET TABLES: If the event is a banquet and center pieces are used on the tables, the height of each piece should be **no higher than eye level** when people are seated at the table.

6. ITEMS NEEDED ON STAGE:

- 1 Wooden stool with flat top(no cushion)
- 2 Chairs with no arms(preferably not a folding chair unless nothing else is available)
- 2 Bottles of water
- 3 New decks of blue, standard Bicycle playing cards

7. VIDEO REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 large screens no smaller than 12ft by 9ft (one on either side of the stage). If 2 can't be provided, one screen no smaller than 20ft by 15ft either above the stage or beside. Should be at least 8 feet above the stage and not directly behind Bryan!
- The projector(s) should have HDMI capabilities.


ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

1. LOAD-IN/LOAD-OUT SCHEDULE: Bryan can arrive as early as 3 hours prior to the performance, but he will typically arrive approximately 1 hour prior. It is preferred that the performance area be available for use at this time.

2. PARKING: Arrangements should be made for Bryan's vehicle to have a reserved parking space as close as possible to the entrance he will be using.

3. BACKSTAGE AREA/GREEN ROOM: If there is no backstage area that can be hidden from the audiences view by a curtain, then please provide a room for Bryan, preferably as close to the stage as possible.
